



Fine Fabric Detergent

Low Moisture Upholstery Cleaner

Fine Fabric Detergent is a unique upholstery cleaning detergent which is based on proprietary technology to provide a total solution to upholstery, delicate fabric and rug cleaning.

This innovative multi-task product can be used in one of 3 ways;

- **Encapsulation Cleaning** – Upholstery fabrics and delicate area rugs, a 1:16 solution of Fine Fabric Detergent is spray applied, agitated and allowed to dry.
- **Low Moisture (Dry) Cleaning** – Delicate cottons, a 1:4 solution of Fine Fabric Detergent is whipped up to produce a rich foam which is then used to dry-clean the cotton fabric.
- **Wet Cleaning Delicate Fabrics** – Water cleanable fine fabrics, a 1:16 solution of Fine Fabric Detergent is spray applied, agitated and rinse/extracted with Settler.

BENEFITS

- **Encapsulating** – An advance blend of high performance embrittling and encapsulation agents encapsulate the emulsified soil, embrittling it for easy vacuum removal.
- **Releases Upholstery Soiling** – Fine Fabric Detergent contains ingredients which specifically target body oils and fats, beverage and food stains and organic soils.
- **Leaving Fabrics Chemical Free** – Fine Fabric Detergent residues left in the upholstery or rug fibres dry down to a light, brittle crystal which quickly breaks away from the fibre and is left chemical free.
- **User Friendly** – Low odour formula.
- **Dye and Fabric Stability** – The mildly acidic character of Fine Fabric Detergent helps prevent cellulosic browning and stabilizes fibre dyes.
- **No Resoiling** – Unique embrittling and anti-resoiling polymer ensures that fabrics and fibres stay cleaner for longer.
- **Fibre Safe** – Safe for use on all water cleanable fibres including silk, cotton, linen, wool, stain-resistant nylon and all synthetic fibres.

What is the difference between Fine Fabric Detergent and a carpet encapsulating cleaner?

Fine Fabric Detergent shares a number of similarities with a carpet encapsulating cleaner but with a few critical differences;

- Mildly acidic pH which stabilizes dyes and helps prevent browning.
- The cleaning ingredients chosen for Fine Fabric Detergent, specifically target the oily, greasy soiling typical to upholstery.
- Specialty stain removal agents are included to assist with the removal of beverage, and tannin staining.

Directions for use:

Delicate Area Rugs – Delicate area rugs which are water-cleanable can be cleaned using encapsulation cleaning or the wet cleaning method.

Delicate Cotton Fabrics – These are best cleaned using the Low Moisture (Dry) Cleaning Method.

Fine Fabrics – Upholstery which is water cleanable is best cleaned using the Wet Cleaning Method or the Encapsulation Method.

Note: If the fabric or rug is to be protected using a fluorochemical protector, the treated area must be extract/rinsed.

Always pretest in an inconspicuous location for substrate sensitivity to chemicals.

Multi-task Encapsulating Spot Remover

Encapsulation Cleaning

1. Vacuum fabric to remove all loose soil.
2. Mix 250ml Fine Fabric Detergent with 4 Litres clean water.
3. Spray apply this solution onto the fabric until it is wetted out. (1 Litre of ready to use solution should cover approximately a 4 seater lounge suit.)
4. Agitate solution using a bonnet mitt or an upholstery cleaning brush.
5. Remove excess moisture with a clean, white, dry terry towel.
6. Allow to dry. Assist drying by increasing ventilation.
7. Leave to dry for at least 24 hours before dry vacuuming to remove dry, embrittled soil.

Low Moisture (Dry) Cleaning

1. Vacuum fabric to remove all loose soil.
2. Mix 250ml Fine Fabric Detergent with 1 Litre clean water.
3. Whip-up solution to create a rich foam
4. Apply this foam onto the fabric using a sea sponge, bonnet mitt or upholstery cleaning brush. Agitate to remove maximum amount of soiling.
5. Remove excess foam and moisture with a clean, white, dry terry towel.
6. Allow to dry. Assist drying by increasing ventilation.
7. Leave to dry for at least 24 hours before dry vacuuming to remove dry, embrittled soil.

Wet Cleaning Delicate Fabrics

1. Vacuum fabric or rug to remove all loose soil.
2. Mix 250ml Fine Fabric Detergent with 4 Litres clean water.
3. Spray apply this solution onto the fabric until it is wetted out. (1 Litre of ready to use solution should cover approximately a 4 seater lounge suit or 4m²)
4. Agitate solution using a bonnet mitt or an upholstery cleaning brush.
5. Rinse extract using Settler.
6. Allow to dry. Assist drying by increasing ventilation.
